**Period Covered:** January 1<sup>st</sup> through December 31<sup>st</sup>, 2018

### During this Period Internal Affairs Investigated:

- 7 Formal Complaints (those meeting requirements of Texas Government Code Chapter 614 concerning complaints against Police Officers)
- Within the 7 Formal Complaints received, there were allegations of misconduct made
  - 3 [43%] concerned Conduct Unbecoming
  - 1 [14%] concerned Police Misconduct
  - 1 [14%] concerned Rude/Discourteous Language
  - 1 [14%] concerned Treatment of Persons – Truthfulness
  - 1 [14%] concerned Racial Profiling
- The 7 Formal Complaints resulted in
  - 3 findings of Sustained [Misconduct Occurred]. Two employees received a written reprimand.
  - 3 findings of Unfounded
  - 1 finding of Exonerated
