# **Enclave at River Park PID Background**

- August 19, 2014 City Council Resolution 14-32
- Created a Public Improvement District to finance improvements
  - 54.5 Acre Single Family Development
  - 139 homes platted lots
  - Similar to a MUD but limited authority
    - Eliminates extra layer of government
    - More efficient than a MUD



#### **Enclave at River Park PID**

- PID created to reimburse developer for public infrastructure- similar to an in-City MUD
  - Streets, Drainage, Utilities
- Assessment is NOT for:
  - New neighborhood amenities
  - Maintaining HOA facilities
- All buyers are notified of the Assessment at closing
- Assessment is significantly less than in-City MUD tax



# **Enclave at River Park PID Background**

- Development Agreement states
  - Reimbursement \$2.125M for public infrastructure
  - Developer was reimbursed in January 2019
  - 2018 taxable value exceeded \$31M required
- Annual assessments to properties will be used to pay debt service on reimbursement over 15 years
  - Assessment ends on completion of debt payments




### 2020 Proposed PID Assessment

- 2020 proposed Enclave at River Park PID Assessment is \$560 per lot
  - Assessment is a 24% decline from 2019 of \$740
  - Future assessments anticipated to decline
  - City contributes 50% of property taxes from the PID area similar to in-city MUDs
- Assessments billed on Property Tax statements sent by Fort Bend County Tax Office

# Public Hearing and Feedback

- Notice of Public Hearing mailed to all property owners in the PID as directed in the PID service plan
- Options to submit comments online or via e-mail
  - Comments received from multiple property owners to be read during public hearing
- Hold a Public Hearing
  - Receive and hear all persons on the Enclave at River Park PID assessment for 2020



## Next Steps – PID Assessment

- Receive and hear all persons desiring to speak on the proposed assessment
- Consider Ordinance No. 2208 setting PID
   Assessment for 2020 at \$560 per lot- which is a 24% decrease from last year's assessment
  - First Reading on September 1
  - Second Reading on September 15
