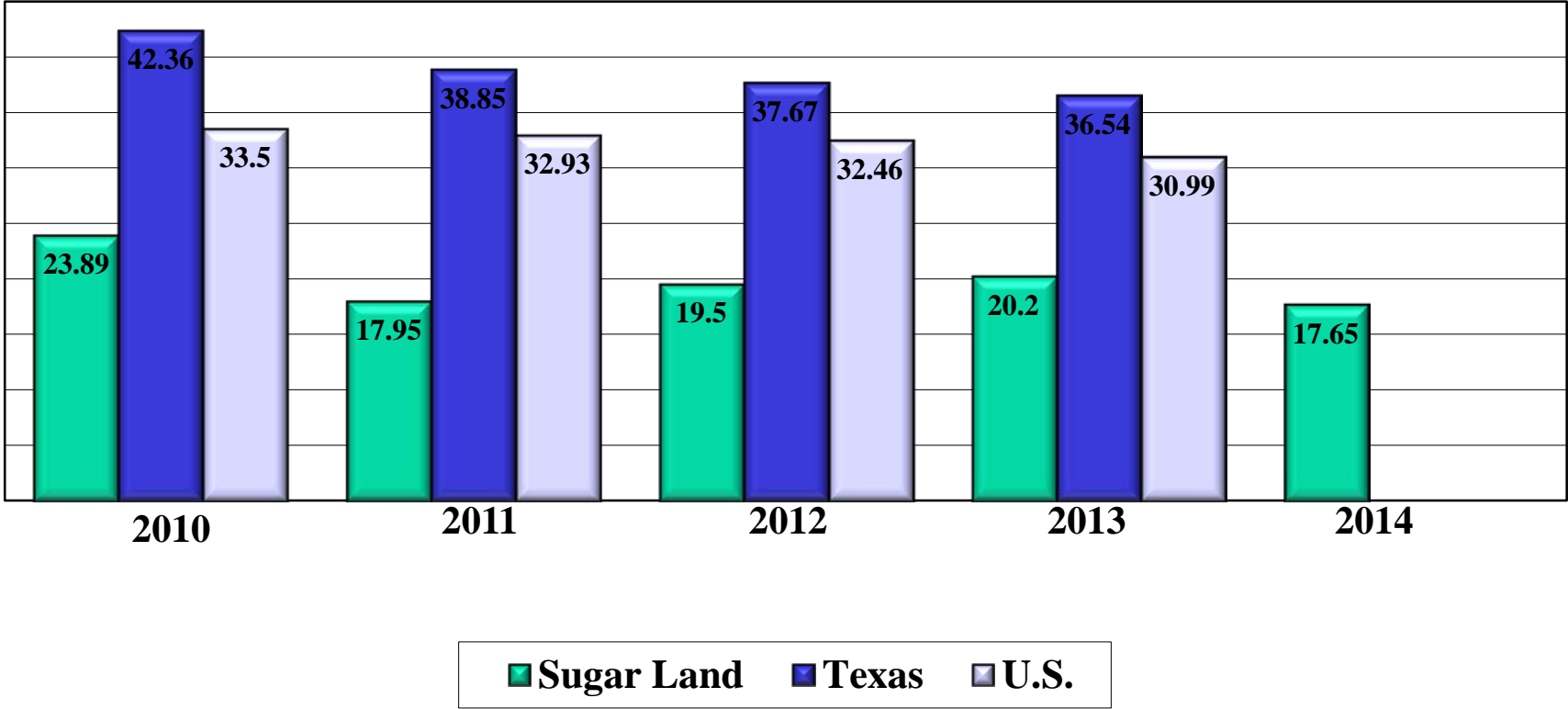

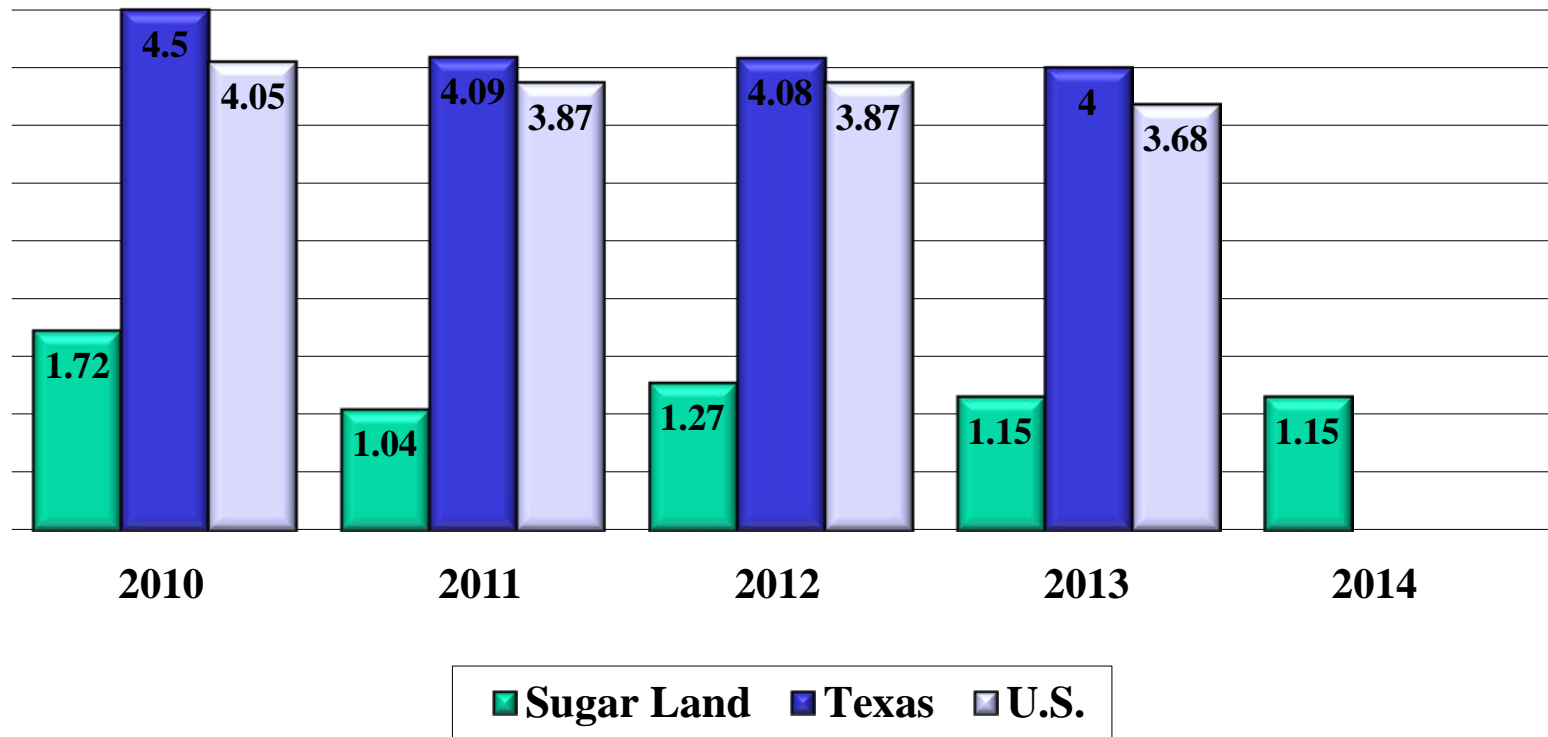


Population 2010 to 2014 – 84,511

# Violent Crime Rate 2010 - 2014

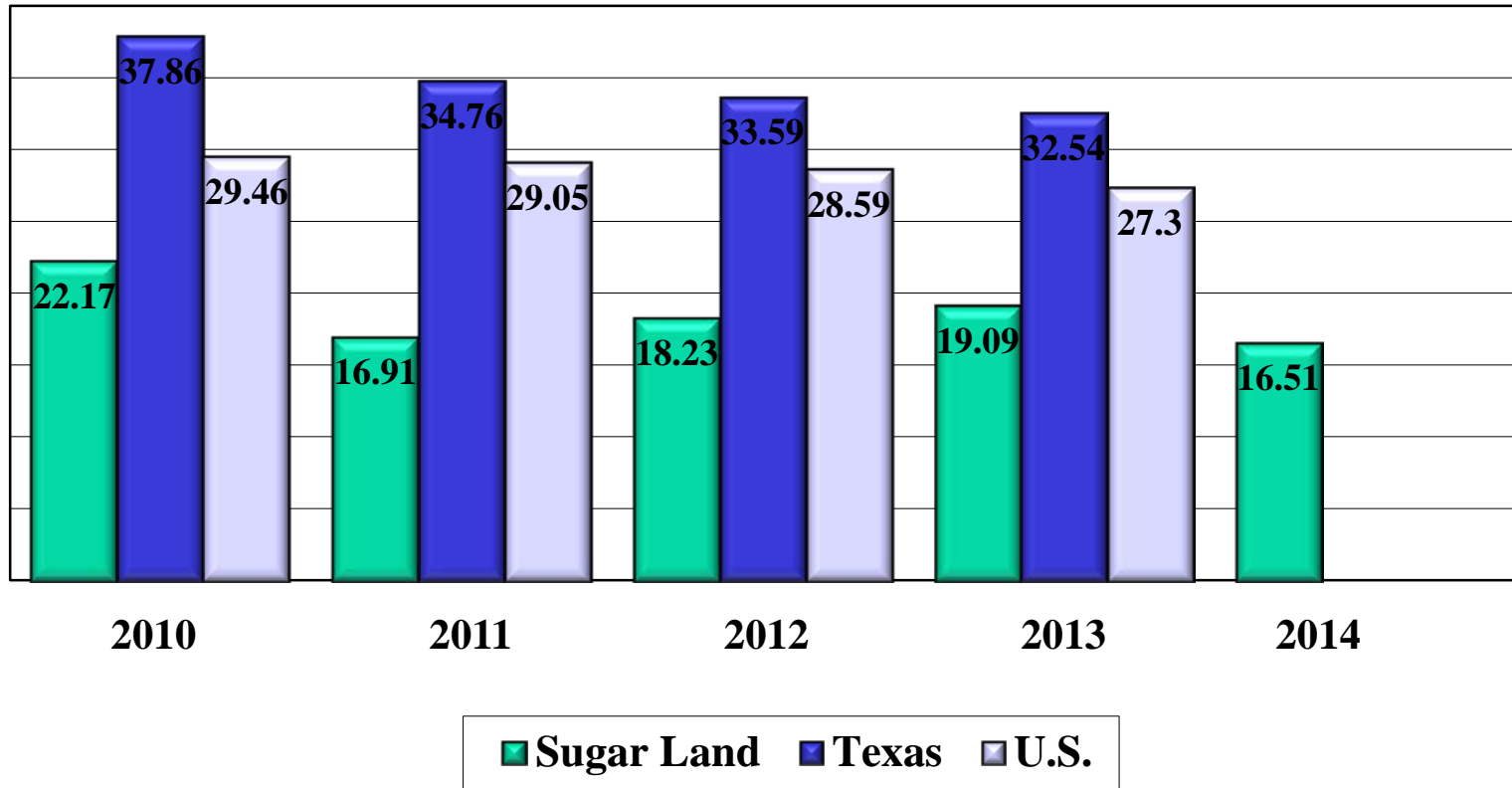

# Property Crime Rate 2010 - 2014



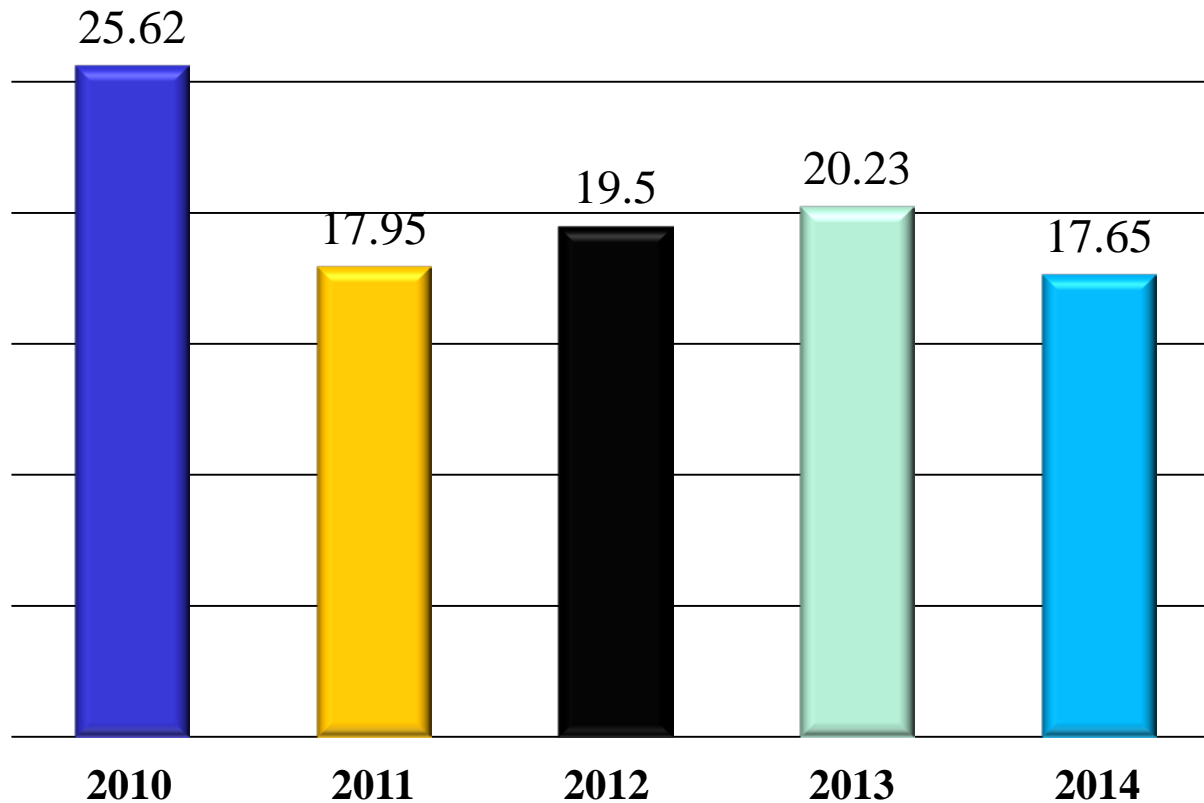

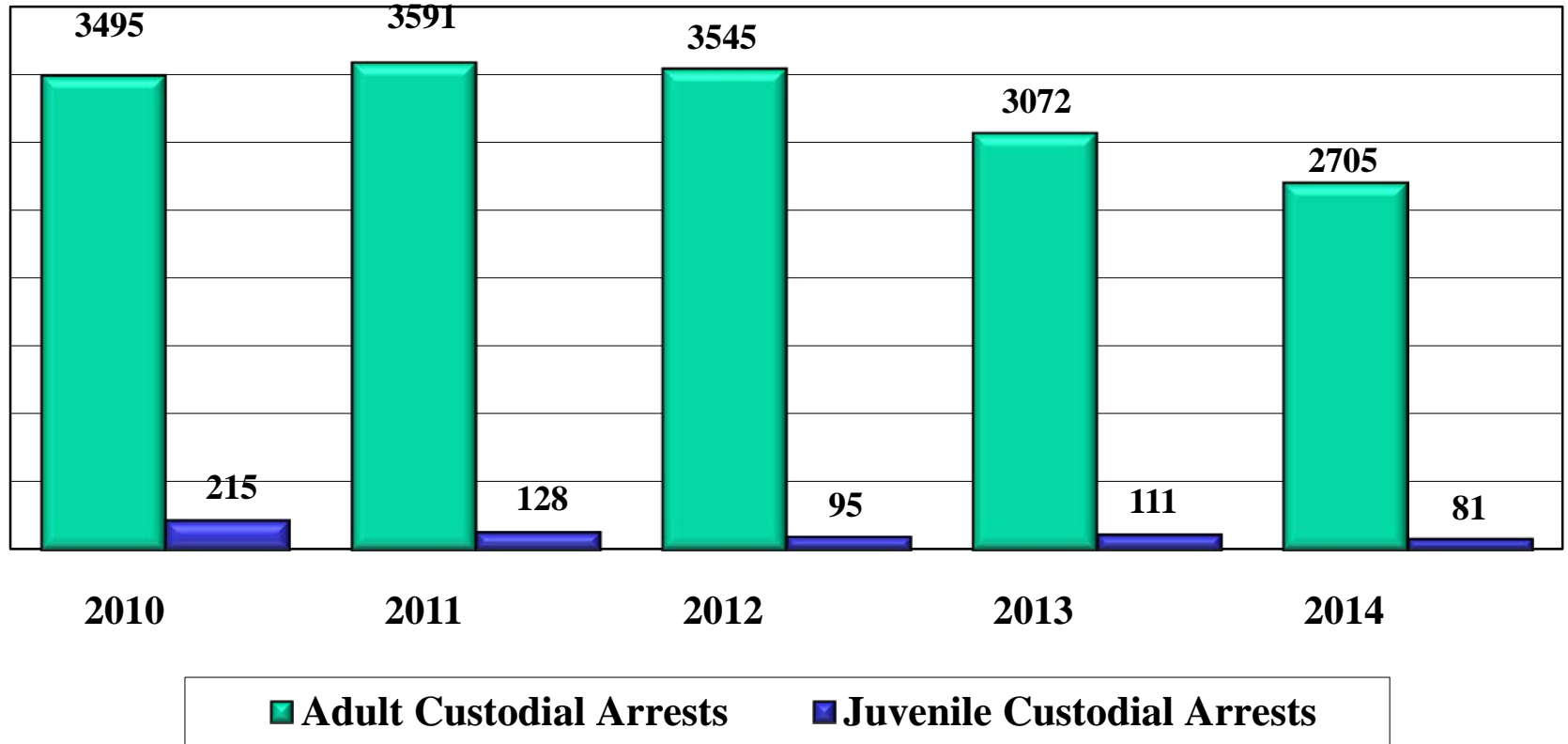

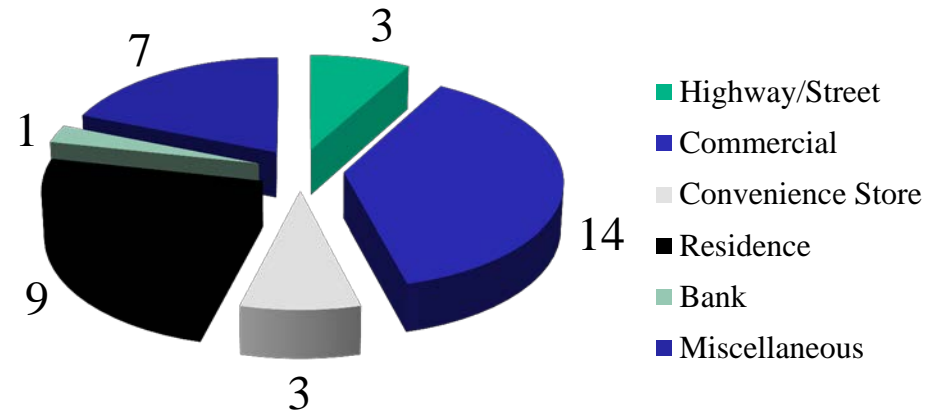

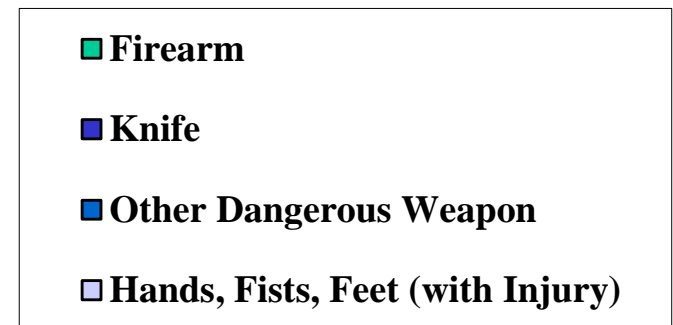
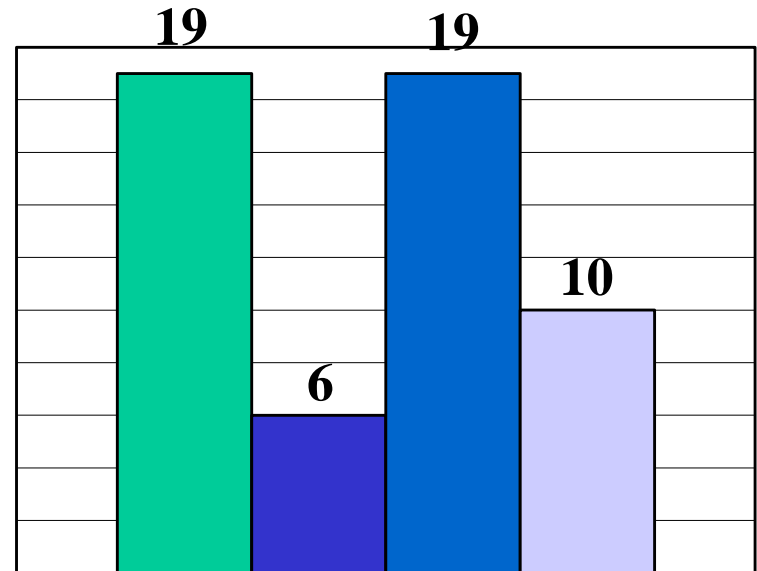
- **Robberies increased from 35 in 2013 to 37 in 2014.**

# Aggravated Assault (2014)

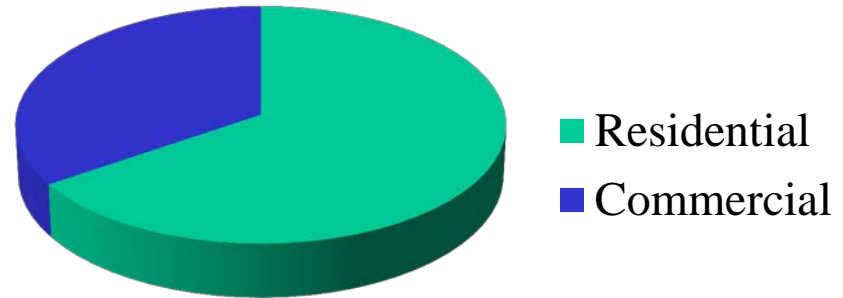
- Aggravated Assaults have decreased from 57 in 2013 to 54 in 2014

# Burglary (2014)

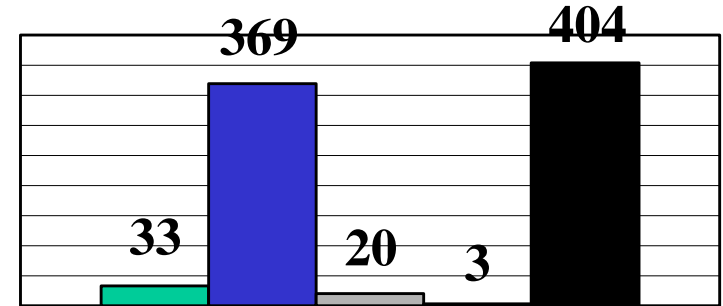
- **Burglaries decreased from 256 in 2013 to 220 in 2014**

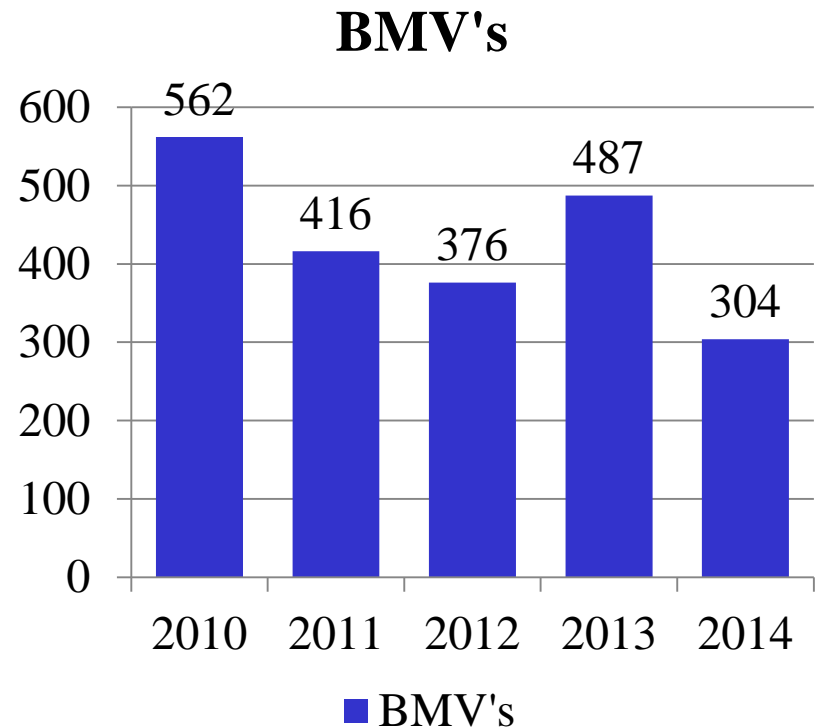

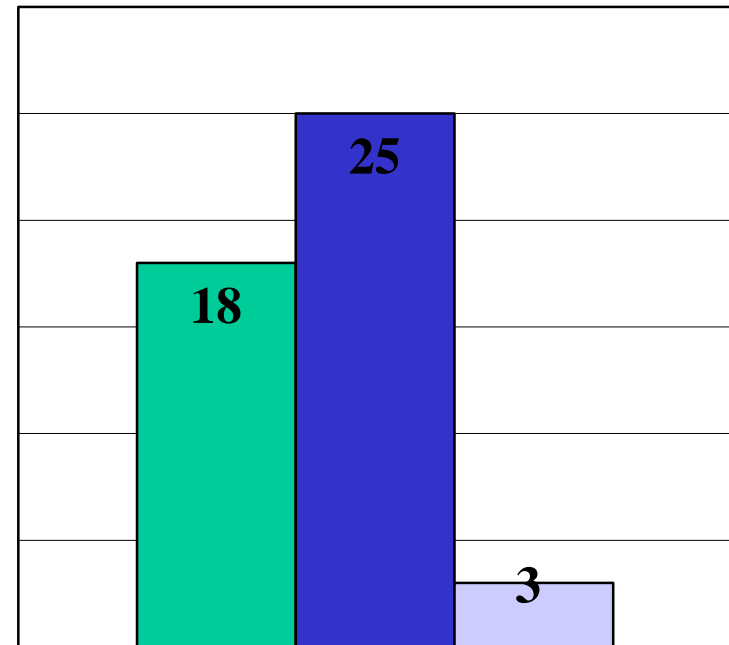
# BMV (2014)

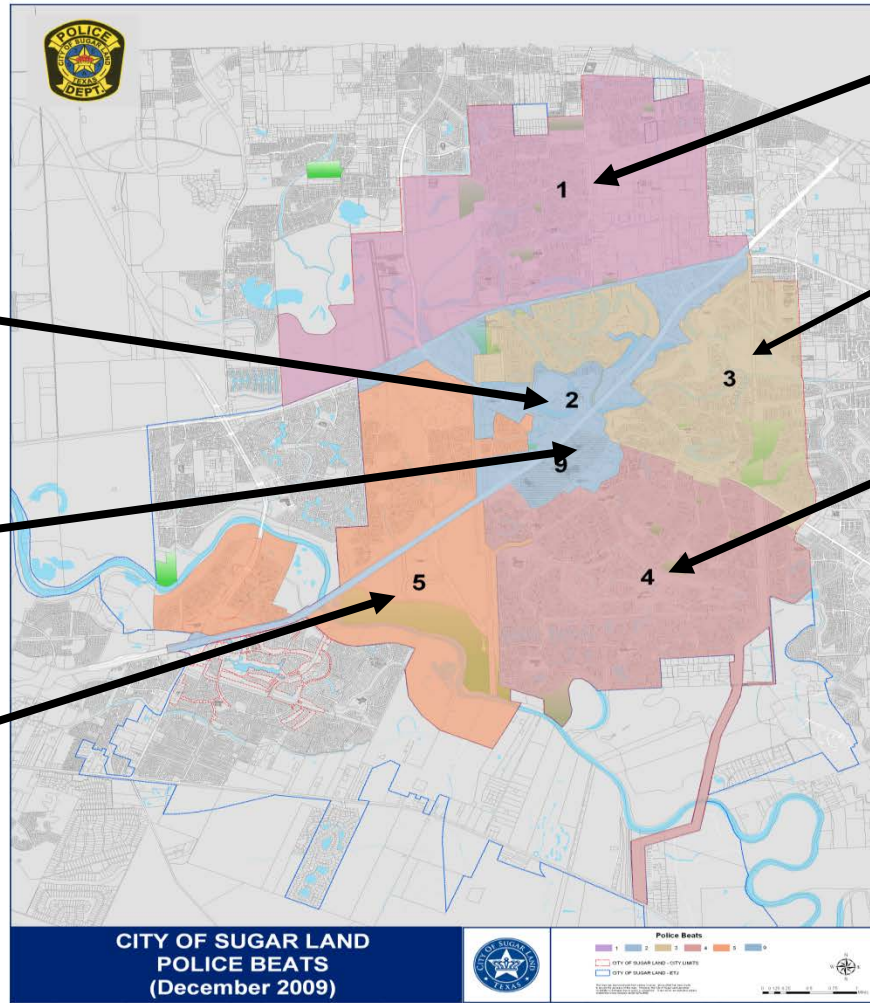

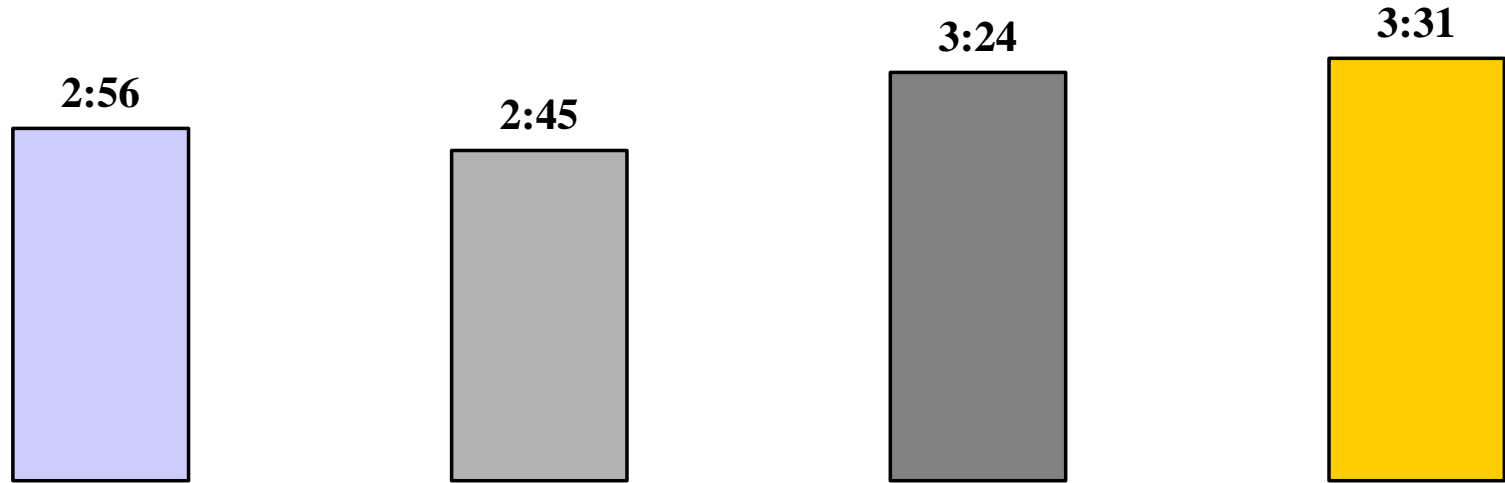

**Definition:** The Graph portrays the time it takes a police officer to respond to a priority one call from when the telephone call is received by the telecommunications operator to the time the first officer arrives at the location. An emergency call is defined as a call in which there exists an imminent threat to life and/or potentially severe property loss. The Patrol Division's goal is to have an average response time to priority one calls of less than five (5) minutes.

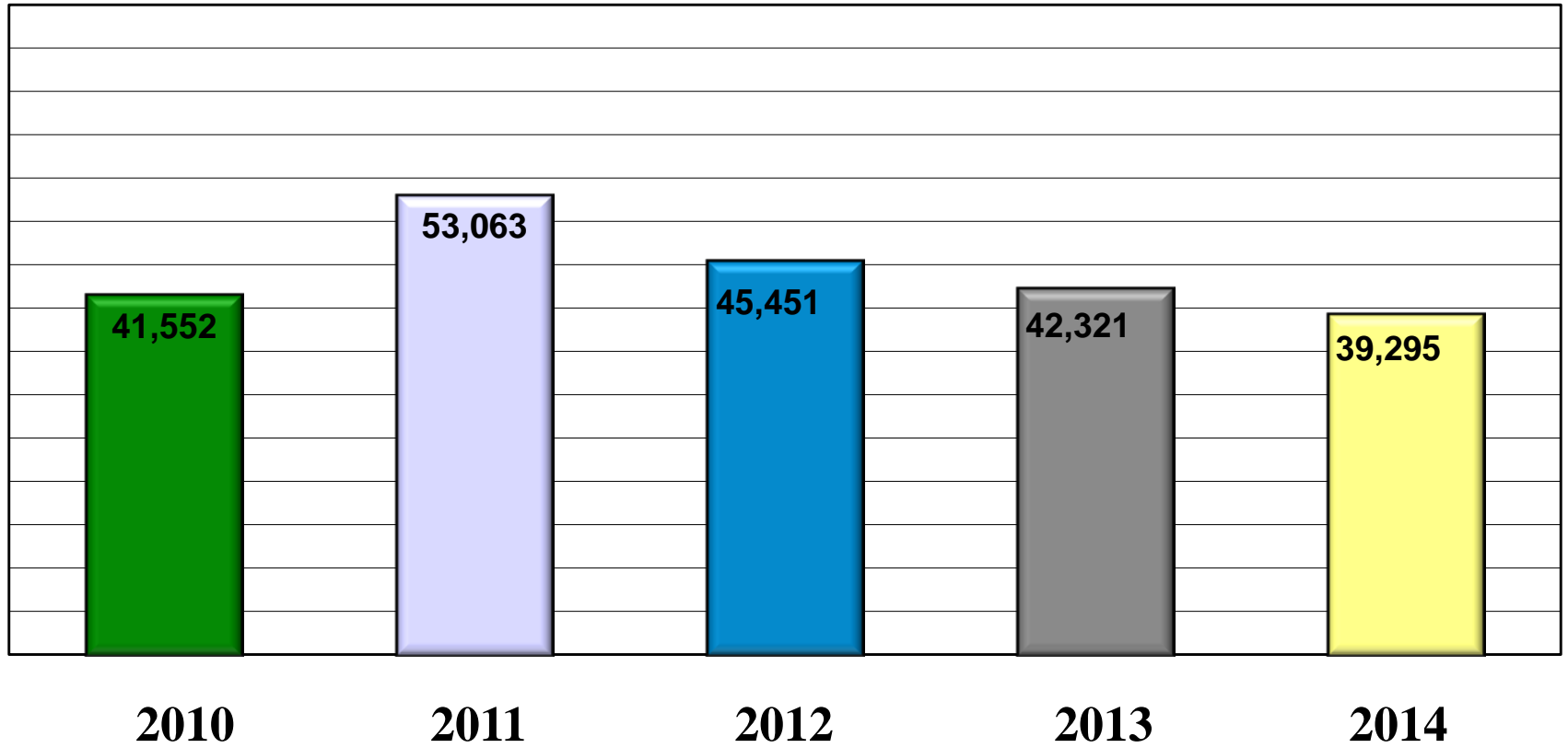

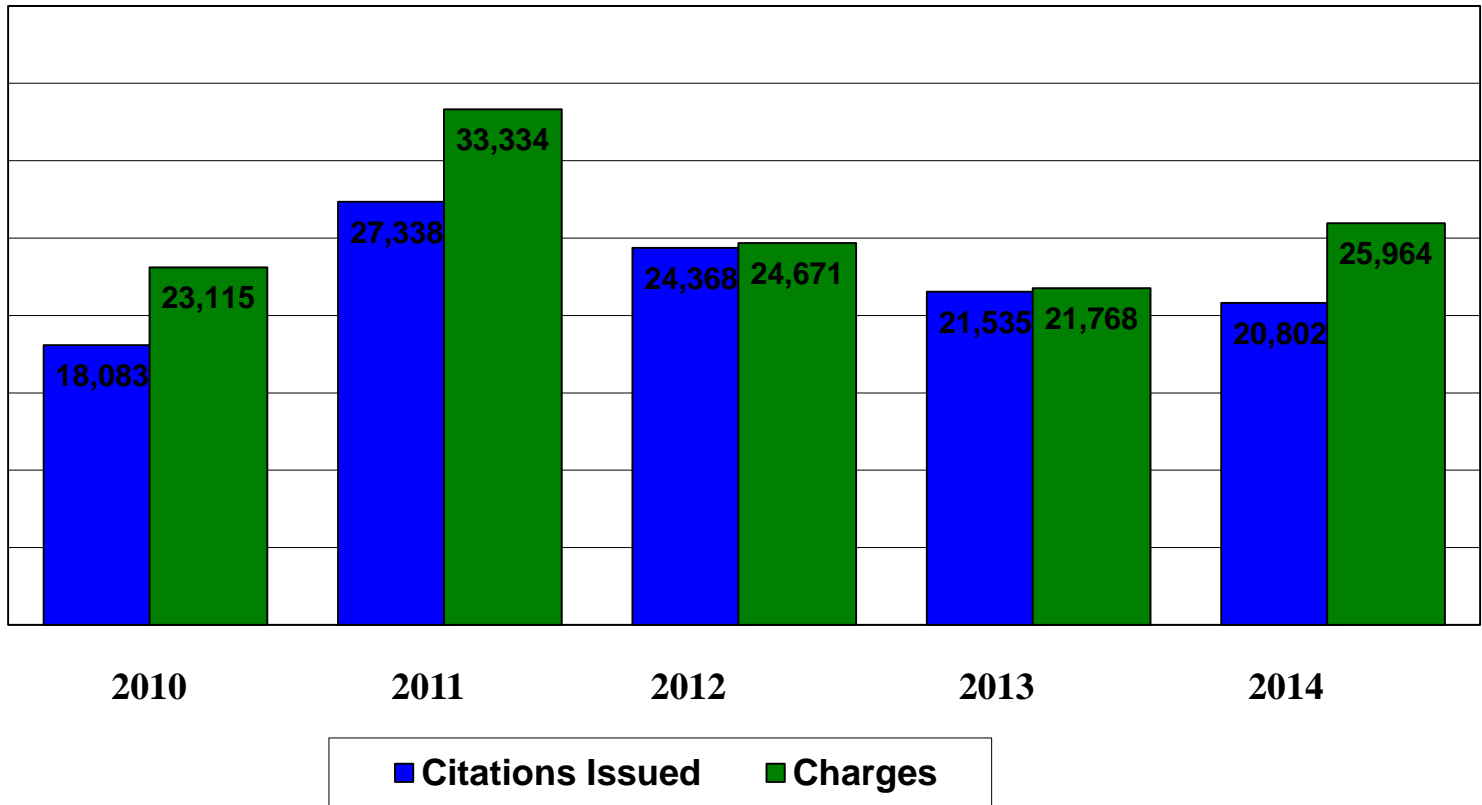


# Number of Traffic Stops

2010 - 2014



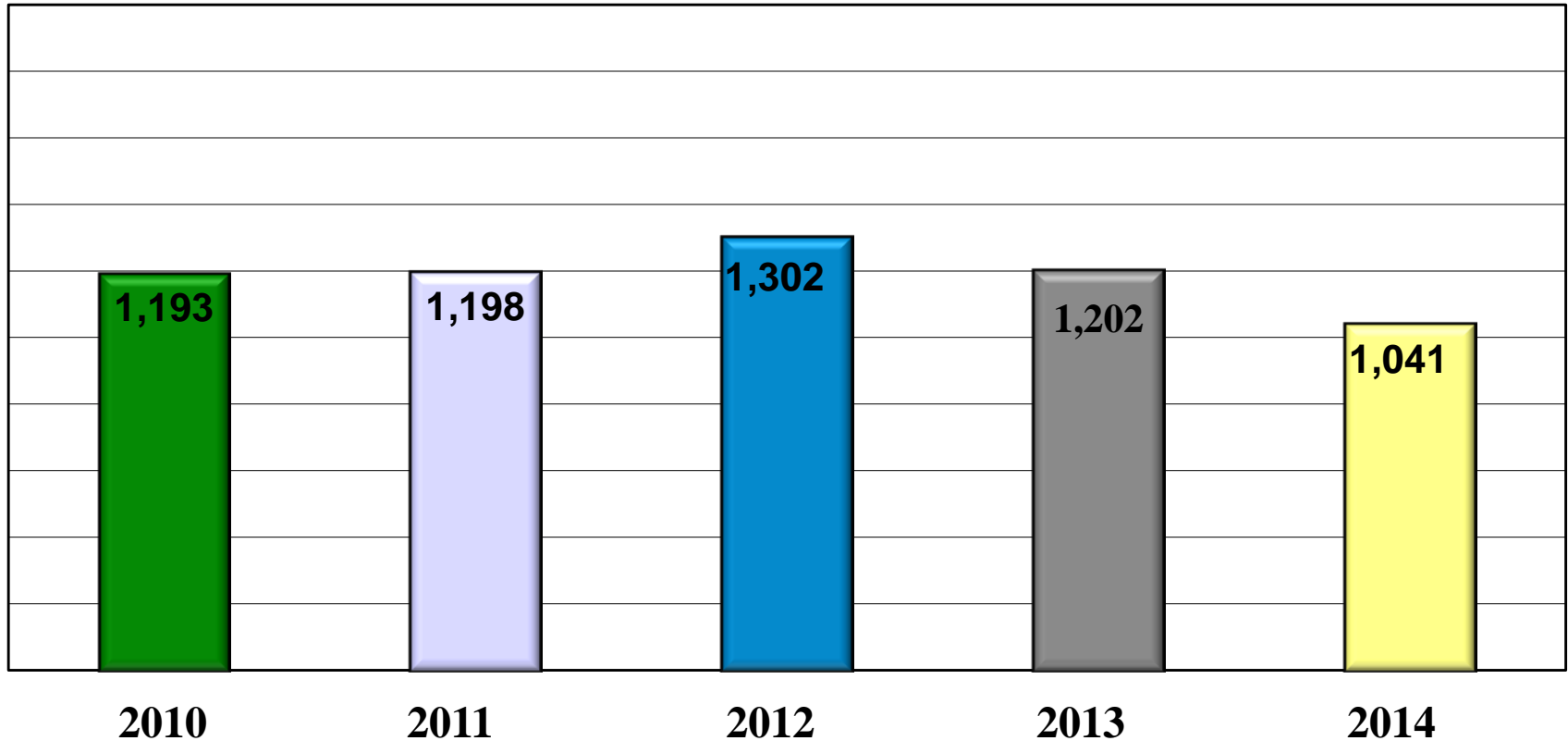
# Citations Issued

**2010 - 2014**



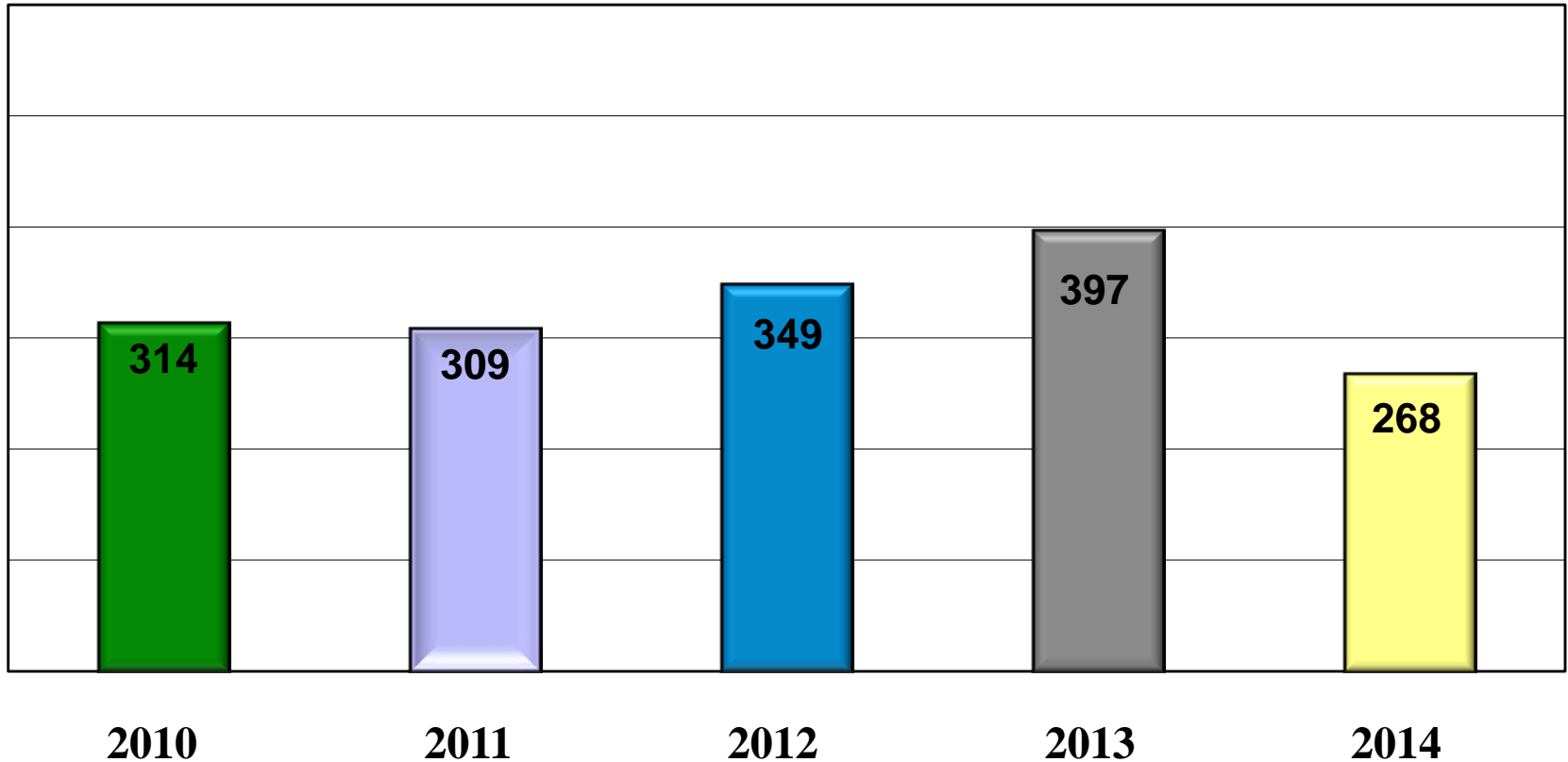

## Injury Collisions

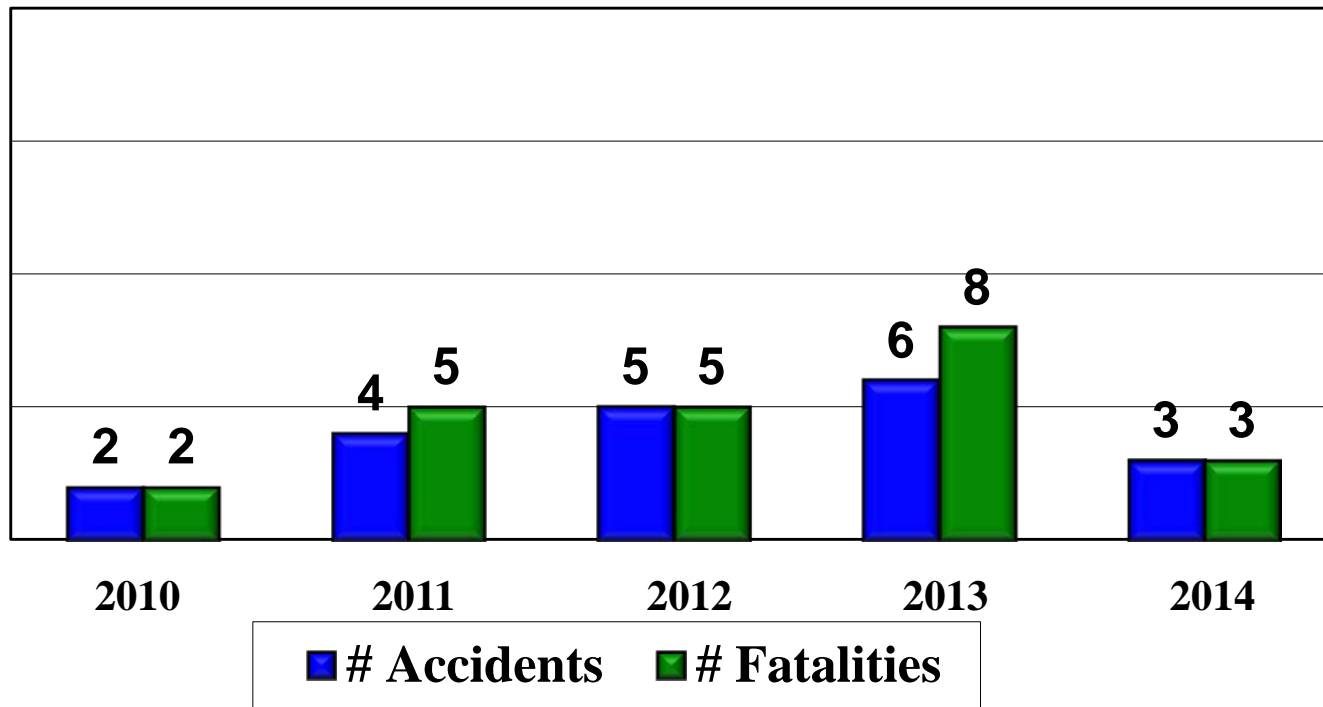
