

ORDINANCE NO. 2160

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SUGAR LAND, TEXAS, CANVASSING THE RETURNS AND DECLARING THE RESULTS OF AN ELECTION HELD ON MAY 4, 2019, TO ELECT A COUNCIL MEMBER TO SINGLE MEMBER DISTRICT ONE, TWO, AND FOUR; CALLING FOR A RUNOFF ELECTION FOR SATURDAY, JUNE 8, 2019, TO ELECT A COUNCIL MEMBER TO SINGLE MEMBER DISTRICT TWO; PROVIDING FOR EARLY VOTING AND NOTICE OF THE RUNOFF ELECTION; AND PROVIDING FOR OTHER MATTERS RELATED TO THE RUNOFF ELECTION.

WHEREAS, on February 5, 2019, city council approved ordinance no. 2150 ordering an election to be held on May 4, 2019, for the purpose of electing district council members for districts 1, 2, 3, and 4; and

WHEREAS, on March 5, 2019, city council approved ordinance no. 2155, declaring election of unopposed candidate for single member district 3; and

WHEREAS, notice of the election was given as required by law and the returns of the election have been made by the proper officers and canvassed by the City Council; NOW THEREFORE;

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL
OF THE CITY OF SUGAR LAND, TEXAS**

Section 1. That at the election held on May 4, 2019, the following votes were cast for the following candidates:

Section 2. That because none of the candidates for Council Member District Two received a majority vote, the mayor shall certify in writing, for the placement on a runoff election ballot for June 8, 2019, the names of the runoff candidates and deliver the certification to the city secretary as required by section 2.027 of the Election Code:

Section 3. Runoff Election Voting Locations and Voting Hours on Election Day. The voting locations for voting on Election Day are as set forth in Exhibit A attached hereto and incorporated herein as Countywide Election Day Vote Centers, or at such other locations as hereafter may be designated by the County Elections Administrator. On Election Day the polls shall be open from 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m.

Section 4. Runoff Early Voting Locations, Dates and Times. Early voting by personal appearance for all election precincts shall be held at the locations, at the times and on the days set forth in Exhibit B, or at such other locations as hereafter may be designated by the County Elections Administrator.

The County Elections Administrator, John Oldham, is hereby designated as the Early Voting Clerk. Applications for ballots to be voted by mail will be received until 5:00 p.m. May 28, 2019 and should be mailed to:

Section 5. Runoff Joint Election. That John Oldham, Elections Administrator of Fort Bend County, Texas will act as Contracting Officer and will appoint election judges, alternate judges and clerks as described in the Joint Election Agreement and Contract for Election Services between the County of Fort Bend, City of Sugar Land, and other Political Subdivisions.

Section 6. Appointment of Election Officers. Prior to the Election Day, the election judges, alternate judges, clerks and other personnel necessary for conducting the Election will be appointed by the County Elections Administrator, and the election judges and alternate judges may be changed pursuant to decisions of the County Elections Administrator. The County Elections Administrator shall be responsible for establishing the central counting station for the ballots case in such election and appointing the personnel necessary for such station.

Section 7. Notice of Runoff Election. Notice of the Election, in English and Spanish, shall be (i) published on the same day in each of two successive weeks in a newspaper of general circulation within the City territory, with the first publication to be not earlier than the fifteenth (15th) day before the election; (ii) posted on the bulletin board used by the City Council to post notices of meetings no later than the fifteenth (15th) day before the date of the Election; and (iii) posted, not later than the fifteenth (15th) day before the date of the Election, in three (3) public places within the City.

Section 8. Conduct of Runoff Election. Said Election shall be held in accordance with the Election Code as amended, including Chapter 272 of the Election Code pertaining to bilingual requirements.

Section 9. Voting System. Voting at the election, including early voting, will be by use of the County electronic voting system that has been approved by the Secretary of State.

Section 10. Runoff Canvass. The official canvass will be conducted on June 18, 2019. Under Article II Sec. 2.01 (d) of the City Charter, the persons elected shall take the oath of office and begin their duties at the meeting at which the City Council declares the results of the election.

ADOPTED on first and final consideration on May 14, 2019, in compliance with Section 2.09 (a)(2) of the City Charter.
