


# MULTI-LANE ROUNDABOUT

# NAVIGATING A MULTI-LANE ROUNDABOUT

- 1** When approaching a multi-lane roundabout, look for the advance lane control sign and choose the lane for your turning movement.
- 2** Observe traffic signs and look for pedestrians in the crosswalk on the roundabout approach.
- 3** Yield to traffic circulating in the roundabout. Reduce your speed when travelling through a roundabout.
- 4** Follow the arrow markings and do not change lanes in the roundabout circle.
- 5** Use your right turn signal when exiting the roundabout. Also look for pedestrians in the crosswalk.
- 6** If a semi-trailer, bus, or other large vehicle approaches a multi-lane roundabout, give way to the large vehicle (whom may need to take more than one lane when circulating the roundabout).
- 7** If an emergency vehicle (with flashing lights) approaches, do not stop in the roundabout circle. Either pull over before entering or exit the roundabout and pull over.
