

# SINGLE-LANE ROUNDABOUT

## LANE MOVEMENT & TURN OPTIONS



### PATH DIRECTION

- Entry
- Through
- Left Turn
- U-Turn
- Right Turn

**Bike Path Alternative:**  
Bicyclists have the option of travelling through the roundabout or using the slip ramps (if available)

### SIGNS

- A** Roundabout Ahead
- B** Crosswalk
- C** Exit Street Sign
- Yield

# NAVIGATING A

## SINGLE-LANE ROUNDABOUT

- 1** When approaching a roundabout, observe traffic signs and look for pedestrians in the crosswalk.
- 2** Yield to traffic circulating in the roundabout. Reduce your speed when travelling through a roundabout.
- 3** When entering the roundabout, look for circulating vehicles and vehicles entering the roundabout to your left. Do not need to wait for entering vehicles across and to the right of you.
- 4** Use your right turn signal when exiting the roundabout. Also look for pedestrians in the crosswalk.
- 5** If an emergency vehicle (with flashing lights) approaches, do not stop in the roundabout circle. Either pull over before entering the roundabout or exit the roundabout and pull over.
