

RESOLUTION NO. 23-18

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SUGAR LAND, TEXAS, APPOINTING A 2023 REDISTRICTING ADVISORY COMMITTEE TO MAKE RECOMMENDATIONS TO THE CITY COUNCIL ON THE ADOPTION OF A REDISTRICTING PLAN.

WHEREAS, the City Charter of the City of Sugar Land provides for a seven-member city council with four members elected from single-member districts and the mayor and two members elected at-large; and

WHEREAS, to insure equality of representation in the political process, the law requires that the four single-member districts contain approximately equal numbers of persons; and

WHEREAS, as a result of the 2020 Census, the City must reapportion its single-member districts to provide for equal numbers of persons in each district; and

WHEREAS, the City Council wishes to establish a 2023 Redistricting Advisory Committee (the Committee) to make recommendations to the City Council on one or more redistricting plans; and

WHEREAS, each of the seven City Council members have nominated one person to serve on the Committee for the Council's approval and the Mayor has selected from those members the person who will serve as the chair of the Committee; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor has nominated two former City Council members to serve on the Committee; NOW THEREFORE,

**BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL
OF THE CITY OF SUGAR LAND, TEXAS:**

Section 1. That the City Council appoints the following members to serve on the Committee:

1. Bob Barbour
2. Chris Barnett
3. Sue Chiang
4. Jim Levermann
5. Shail Momin


6. Bridget Yeung
7. Harvey Zinn

Section 2. That the Mayor has appointed Harvey Zinn to serve as the chair of the Committee.

Section 3. That the Mayor has appointed the following former City Council members Mary Von Tungeln and Himesh Gandhi to serve on the Committee.

Section 4. That the Committee's recommendations for a redistricting plan will follow the guidelines adopted by City Council Resolution No. 23-19, a copy of which is attached to this Resolution.


